

CHAPTER 10
TOWN OF RIB FALLS
MARATHON COUNTY, WISCONSIN
ORDINANCE

"FIREWORKS"

THE PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE IS TO CONTROL THE STORAGE, USE, SALE OF FIREWORKS IN THE TOWN OF RIB FALLS BECAUSE OF THE DANGER OF HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE PUBLIC.

NOW THEREFORE THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF RIB FALLS HEREBY PROHIBITS THE FOLLOWING PER WI. STATE STATUTES 167.10.:

1. No person may store or handle fireworks on premises
2. No person may sell or possess with intent to sell fireworks.
3. No person may possess or use fireworks.
4. No person may allow or permit fireworks to be used or exploded on his or her premise.

"FIREWORKS" means anything manufactured, processed or packaged for exploding, emitting sparks or combustion which does not have another common use - as further stated in Wi. Statute 167.10.

"PERSON" to mean "anyone" - wholesaler, dealer, jobber.

- PENALTY: Any person who violates this ordinance as permitted in Statute 167.10 (5) shall be fined not more than \$1,000.00.

Should any portion of this ordinance be declared invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

This ordinance shall be in full force as effect after its passage and publication as provided by law.
