

ADDENDUM TO CHAPTER 6 – USE OF TOWN HALL

The Town Board of the Town of Rib Falls, Marathon County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section #1: **A. Regulating Use of Town Hall**

1. Use of Town hall limited to local residents only. Local residents shall mean any person whose bona fide domicile is and has been for more than 30 days in the Town of Rib Falls.

B. Town Hall Fees:

1. Weddings, parties and meetings: \$75.00
2. The Rib Falls Town Board will have the discretion to exempt any or all hall fees or may regularly scheduled meetings of non-profit organizations from Rib Falls.
3. A security deposit of \$75.00 shall be required in addition to the applicable fee. The security deposit shall be used for the purpose of paying for any damages caused by or clean-up required after use of said premises by the applicant. The Town Board shall solely determine the amount of any security deposit to be retained by the Town after use of the hall. The remainder of the security deposit shall be returned to the applicant within ten (10) days after the regularly scheduled Board meeting following the event.

C. Application for Permit:

1. Application in writing on such form as the Clerk shall require to be made to the Clerk of the Town of Rib Falls for use of said Town Hall.
2. The making of such application shall constitute an agreement by the applicant and person signing the application that in case the hall is let to the applicant, the applicant or adult sponsor of the applicant will clean and restore the premises to the condition before use by the applicant and will replace, pay for and be responsible for all damage to the premises or equipment therein, which has occurred thereon due in whole or in part to the activities of any person or persons who are invited or permitted by the applicant on said premises.

D. Chaperones:

1. One chaperone must be present at all Youth meetings, parties, and dances in the Town Hall for persons under the age of 21.

E. Miscellaneous Regulations:

1. No applicant shall hold a dance, party, etc. in the Town hall which is open to the general public or to which an admission fee is charged.

2. Interpretation: Should any question arise concerning the interpretation or application of these rules to any particular person, firm, corporation, or group, or in any particular circumstances, the decision of the Town Board shall govern.

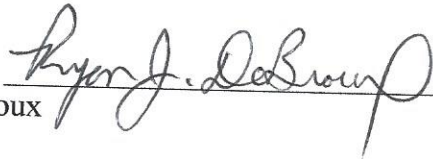
F. Alcoholic Beverages and Food:

1. No alcoholic beverages or food shall be permitted outside the Town Hall.

G. Time Limit:

1. Functions must be over by 12:00 midnight and premises vacated by 12:30 AM.
