

CHAPTER 21

ORDINANCE DESIGNATING SNOWMOBILE ROUTE

Section 1. Intent:

The Town of Rib Falls of Marathon County WI adopts the following ordinance for the purpose of designating the named town highways as snowmobile routes.

Section 2. Statutory Authority:

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the statutory authority under Sec. 350.18 of WI Statutes.

Section 3. Designation of Named Town Highways as Snowmobile Routes:

The following town highways are hereby designated snowmobile routes:

Beginning ½ mile south of the intersection of W 24th St and 9th Ave proceeding to W 24th St; ½ mile west on W 24th St.

Section 4. Conditions of designation as snowmobile routes:

The following conditions shall apply to the designated snowmobile routes:

(a) Snowmobile operators shall be limited to the operation as stated in Sec 350.04 (2) of WI Statutes and any other provisions of Chapter 350.

(b) The town highways designated as snowmobile routes shall be marked as snowmobile routes in accordance with Sec 350.13 of WI Statutes.

(c) A copy of this ordinance shall be sent to the County Sheriff's Dept.

Section 5. Enforcement:

This ordinance shall be enforced by any law enforcement officer of the State of Wisconsin or County of Marathon.

Section 6. Penalties:

The penalties under Sec. 350.11 of WI Statutes are hereby adopted by reference.


Section 7. Severability:

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision of application, and to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.


Section 8. Effective Date:

This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and posting.
