RECYCLING RULES

Glass, aluminum, tin and steel cans, and plastic shall be mixed together in the <u>Commingle Container</u>

Newspaper, magazines, cardboard, and office paper shall be mixed together in the <u>Cardboard Container</u>

All non-recyclable materials shall be placed in the <u>Trash Container</u>

When in doubt, throw it out!

Everything must be clean but does not have to be separated
Batteries to include: Auto, Lawn Mower, Motorcycle
Oil in 1 Gallon or Less Leak Proof Containers & Marked Oil (Milk Jugs work good)
