

# **TOWN OF RIB FALLS REGULAR BOARD MEETING**

## MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Draeger at 6:00 pm.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Randy made a motion to approve the agenda. John second. Motion carried.

6:15 PM Open Dust Control Bid - One Dust Control bid was received from Kafka. One full truckload of 38% Calcium Chloride is \$1.60/gallon, 32% Magnesium Chloride is \$1.55/gallon. Randy made a motion to approve the Dust Control received from Kafka for Calcium Chloride and Magnesium Chloride for township use only. Jim second. Motion passed. A granite bid from Red Rock was mailed after our deadline.

The minutes from the March 10, 2026 board meeting were reviewed. Jim made a motion to approve the minutes. John second. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Lee's Equipment brought furnace and air conditioner replacement quotes for the town hall. The furnace is 27 years old, parts are becoming obsolete and its life expectancy is 20 years. Bill Wunsch reminded us that tax increases have been approved with the intention of improving town roads versus other projects like air conditioning or town signage.

Torrie read the Treasurer's Report. Randy made a motion to file the Treasurer's Report. Jim second. Motion carried.

Clerk's Report – Election turnout was good. 284 voters, 6 new registrations. We had a representative from the Wisconsin Elections Commission observe our polling place to see if we are ADA compliant. We have not gotten the results back from that yet. Need to complete Recycling Grant report and finish Form CT.

Appoint Additional Election Workers – Jenny Nowak completed the required 6 hrs of training to be a Chief Election Inspector and Susan Schmidt completed the training to be an Election Worker. John made a motion to appoint Jenny Nowak as a Chief Election Inspector and Susan Schmidt as an Election Worker. Randy second. Motion passed.

Supervisor's Reports – Cleanup from large snow storm in March went well. Brian did a lot of grading before the rainfall this week. There are a couple rotten culverts on Pheasant Falls Rd & Highland Dr. Knauf Excavating will start ditching on Boulder Falls Trl. JJ's Brushing will start with brushing throughout the township next week. When our culverts were inventoried, we had one culvert that was rated a 4. The state suggested we apply for the Small Structure Grant to see if it gets covered, even though their program is for culverts rated 5 or higher. We have one culvert for the 50/50 County program, the application has been filed. Draeger Dairy will be hosting the June Dairy breakfast in 2027.

- a. Discuss Security Cameras for Town Hall & Shop – We have not found an option that will work without internet.
- b. Discuss Town Sign Options to be Presented at the Annual Meeting - John received an estimate for an electronic sign that would be mounted onto the building which would be \$16,500.

- c. Discuss Painting of Building Options to be presented at the Annual Meeting – Pressure Wash, Prime & Paint estimate received from Chuck Mengel.
