ORDINANCE NO. 32-2017

RE: 13TH LANE SPEED LIMIT REDUCTION AND SPEED LIMIT SET TO 35 MILES PER HOUR

The Town Board of the Town of Rib Falls, Marathon County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under Wisconsin State Statutes, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town roads in the town as follows:

A. Effective March 1, 2017, speed limits on certain Town of Rib Falls town roads are reduced or modified as follows:

13th Lane, Town of Rib Falls, Marathon County is set as follows:

Thirty-five miles per hour for all vehicles from its intersection with State Highway 107 westerly for a distance of 0.35 of a mile.

B. Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes, the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.


This ordinance is effective on publication and posting on March 1st, 2017.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.


